SB 1012 Sponsors-- <u>Senators</u>: Jim Barcia - (primary) Gerald Van Woerkom, Mark Jansen, Mike Nofs, John Gleason, Alan Cropsey, Cameron Brown, Roger Kahn

The bill exempts Personal Property Tax on equipment used to install field tile for agricultural purposes on qualified agricultural land. Introduced on 12-8-09, Referred to the Senate Committee on Finance. **MLICA Supports.**

HB 5984 Sponsors—<u>Representatives</u>: Kevin Daley (primary) Tyler, Pavlov, Huckleberry, Bryum, Hansen, Mayes, Espinoza, Kurtz, Meltzer, Haase, Barnett, Liss, Proos, DeShazor, Denby, Bolger, Nerat, Genetski, Sheltrown, Valentine, and Stamas.

On March 1st --myself along with MLICA Board Members Russ Talaski and Trevor Young traveled to Lansing to make legislative contacts with our MLICA Legislative Director, Scott Everett.

Prior to this day I didn't know really what to expect. Like you, I spend my days moving dirt and let others worry about having meetings. But, since I've been elected to the MLICA Board, talking to legislators comes with the job, that's what I was told anyway.

The day was not what I expected, I kind of thought we'd end up talking mostly about legislation or a bunch of things I didn't understand. That didn't turn out to be the case. I found both legislators and their staffers to be very interested in what we do and about the business that we are in. They asked about what ideas we had that would help us to improve our businesses. You know, the type of things you sit in the excavator and sometimes think about-- but don't have anyone to tell. So, Russ, Trevor and me made the most out of letting them know what was on our minds.

We met with Senator Jim Barcia and his Chief of Staff, Brandon Dillion about Senate Bill 1012 that would exempt Personal Property Tax on our equipment used for an agricultural purpose.

Next, we met with Senator Gerald VanWoerkom's staff Jeff Cobb and Derek Bagma, to further talk about our industry, along with the arguments for and against our legislation. I found both of these guys very sharp, wanting to know everything because they wanted to help us.

We also met with Representative Kevin Daley. Representative Daley is in his first term and what a great visit we had with him. Representative Daley is a farmer from Lapeer County, so we had a good long visit about agricultural drainage because he knew exactly what we were talking about. Representative Daley is going to also sponsor the personal property tax exemption bill in the House.

Overall, an unexpected and successful day, the type of thing I am convinced we need to do more of. If we don't take the time to visit with our elected officials-even just about what we do everyday, nobody else is going too.

Next year when you see the date for the MLCA legislative day, take the time to make the trip to Lansing.



Friends & Family.....Well I went to the see a Dr. Chen at U of M in Ann Arbor on the 6th of May. I was referred to them by my, Dr.Fouts from Ft. Wayne, In. I was able to take along all my records from 11 months ago when I was first diagnosed. They, (U of M), did a high resolution cat scan on my lungs. The results were not positive. 
Some good news is that they want me in a research program ASAP! To see what they can do for me, and learn as much information as possible about me and my family and work history.




